### A Word from the Board

Hello friends! Summer is finally here, and you can feel it all around you. The sound of birds chirping in the early morning and their lively presence signal the renewal and rhythm of life.

At WTC, we are excited to see you experience Christ's freedom and be part of your spiritual journey as you walk hand in hand with your Saviour, Jesus Christ. He calls you to explore new depths of life with him and invites you to draw closer every day. Seeing the transformative work the Lord is doing within you is amazing. *It is already happening. Surely you can see it.*

The key to transformative work is for God's people to get closer to him intentionally. Think for a moment: in the past, the Israelites did not see these transformative works because they kept turning away from God and worshiping idols instead. They broke their covenant with God and rebelled against God. Even though God wanted to do new things with them, they were in a tough spot, dealing with their sins, disobedience, and confusion. They found it difficult to understand God and blamed him for their problems, losing their faith in the process.

The real purpose of the subsequent Babylonian captivity was to interrupt the Israelites' sinful cycle and call them back into relationship. God reminded them that he was the Almighty God, and they could trust him once again. He had the power to overcome the Red Sea and the Egyptian armies in the past, and he could transform the future by reversing the curses of the past and bringing blessings and water to the land and his people. These words were given to them as a promise:

*"Do not remember the former things, or ponder the things of the past. Listen carefully, I am about to do a new thing, now it will spring forth; will you not be aware of it? I will even put a road in the wilderness, rivers in the desert."* (Isaiah 43:18-19 AMP)

Three takeaways from this passage:

1. God wants to do new and amazing things.
2. God promises to turn dry deserts into flourishing, water-rich areas. The evidence of God working within you is all around you. *Surely you can see it!*
3. God may lead you through a tough and challenging path in the wilderness to reach the new future. It can be scary to enter the unknown wilderness without reassurance or security, but if God has brought you there, trust that He will see you through.

If you've attended a Prayer Ministry Course (PMC) or School of Prayer Ministry (SPM), you'll know that during your Prayer Ministry Appointment (PMA), God wants to take you into a special time with Him. He asks us to be open and vulnerable; it may feel like taking a step back to move forward! We know that God doesn't always do the same things in the same manner he's done them before – we are invited to expect the unexpected. Remember, spending intense time with God can transform us, and even though it may feel challenging, it's where our faith grows. Just keep trusting because faith is your key to reaching the Promised Land!

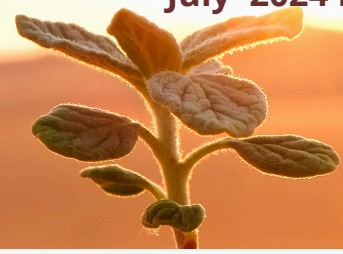

*I want to share how the Lord has been gradually healing me from fibromyalgia symptoms. It has been months of prayer. When I was diagnosed with this illness, the doctor said that it was hereditary and unlikely to improve. However, I have witnessed the Lord's revelation of generational patterns affecting my health.*

*With the support of a WTC team member, I continue to address and pray over these generational wounds that have not only contributed to my illness but also impacted my relationship with Christ. Recently, through another team member, God revealed a physical wound in my spine. I did not have any memory of this wounding but to my surprise, my mom confirmed that I had been wounded (physically and emotionally) at a young age. After this team member prayed and laid hands over me, I experienced a sense of feeling healthy again, with no pain and a sense of vitality. My mother, who has been very skeptical of my conversion to Christianity, said she would like to receive some WTC ministry.*

*I continue to experience relief from pain (without medication), along with a renewed sense of hope and a deeper connection with God and in that connection, with myself and the ways he has created me. Sometimes I wish for instant relief from my symptoms, but I also find myself whispering "thank you" because I am eager to embrace this way of experiencing God's profound love.*
